Day 1: Friday, May 16, 2025 Overnight Flight Wander along medieval walls, marvel at enchanting waterfalls, and relax on sunny islands. From Dubrovnik to Zagreb, set out to experience the best of Croatia and the Adriatic Coast.

Day 2: Saturday, May 17, 2025 Dubrovnik, Croatia - Tour Begins - Board Ship Welcome to Dubrovnik, the “Pearl of the Adriatic.” This afternoon you’ll board a private 4-star ship and revel in all of the luxuries of a small cruise ship. Relax onboard before experiencing a Captain’s welcome dinner. Enjoy your meal accompanied by live Klapa music, the traditional Croatian style of singing. (D)

Day 3: Sunday, May 18, 2025 Dubrovnik - Slano This morning, take in the medieval stone walls, iconic Baroque rooftops, and winding cobblestone streets of Dubrovnik. Embrace the unspeakable feeling that you’ve stepped into another time as you explore the Old City with a local guide. During this walk, be prepared to travel a number of steps and trek carefully across slippery limestone pavements. With free time, perhaps you’ll visit the famous City Walls. In the early afternoon, your journey continues to Slano, a port city just outside of Dubrovnik. Enjoy an evening of leisure or consider an optional excursion to Ston, a nearby fortified city known for its decadent oysters and seafood. (B, L)

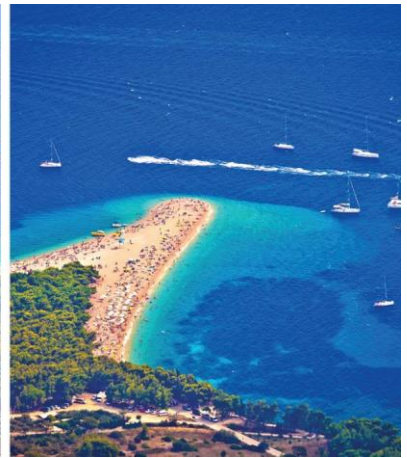
Day 4: Monday, May 19, 2025 Slano - Mljet National Park - Korcula This morning, arrive in Mljet National Park. Stroll around the Large and Small lakes before exploring the Islet of St. Mary, home to a Benedictine Monastery from the 12th century. On this walk, be prepared to step up some stairs and travel by foot on uneven grounds. Don’t miss out on a chance to take a swim in the strikingly blue waters. Then, it’s on to Korcula, debated home to one of the world’s most famous explorers: Marco Polo. Decide for yourself if he was born in Korcula or Venice as you tour his alleged home and take in the fantastic sea views from its tower. Join a local guide and make your way along the narrow stone streets while you wander among the medieval buildings and vibrant houses in the town known as “Little Dubrovnik.” Enjoy the evening at leisure to discover the charms of this age-old city. (B, L)

Day 5: Tuesday, May 20, 2025 Korcula - Vis Cruise on to Vis, a small island overflowing with Renaissance architecture and beautiful beaches. With free time this afternoon, relax onboard the ship enjoy evening at leisure. (B, L)

Day 6: Wednesday, May 21, 2025 Vis - Biševo - Hvar Embark on a morning cruise to the island of Biševo. This island is home to the Blue Cave,* a stunning grotto with a luminous blue glow. Return to the ship and cruise to the sunny island of Hvar. Upon arrival in Hvar, get acquainted with the area when a local guide introduces you to the history, culture, and lifestyle of the city. Discover how lavender was traditionally grown in the region and learn about its uses. Tonight, join your fellow travelers for dinner on board. (B, L, D)

Day 7: Thursday, May 22, 2025 Hvar - Bol - Trogir Start your day in the town of Bol, located on the picturesque island of Brač. With free time this morning, perhaps you’ll choose to swim along the shore of the “Golden Cape,” known to be one of the most popular beaches in Croatia. Return to the ship for lunch, then it’s off to Trogir, a coastal gem renowned for its picturesque Venetian architecture. Admire the striking stone houses and towering cathedral as you tour the city with a guide. (B, L)

Day 8: Friday, May 23, 2025 Trogir - Split Your adventure continues! Discover Split, one of the oldest cities in this historic region. In this bustling port, explore Diocletian’s Palace where you will visit its famous “imperial apartments”. One of Croatia’s UNESCO World Heritage sites, Emperor Diocletian chose the palace to be his retirement home because of the incomparable beauty of Split. A guided tour takes you through the mysterious passageways and into the lower levels of this massive structure. When the city tour

ends, **it's your choice!** Visit the Ethnographic Museum of Split, located in the former residential complex of the Diocletian's palace. This captivating museum showcases exhibits on traditional costumes, crafts and culture in Split including surrounding areas from past centuries **-OR-** explore more of the Diocletian's palace during a visit to its' substructures. Set below the imperial apartments, this represents one of the best-preserved ancient complexes of their kind in the world. (B, D)

Day 9: Saturday, May 24, 2025 Split - Disembark Ship - Šibenik - Vodice Disembark your ship in Split and journey towards Šibenik. Join a local guide on a walking tour through the ancient alleyways and roads of this beautiful town where you'll see the Cathedral of St. James – a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Enjoy your free time in town for lunch before you head to Vodice. Tonight, embrace the culture of Croatia when you meet the owner of a family farm to learn about prosciutto production and enjoy traditional Dalmatian dinner at the farm restaurant. (B, D)

Day 10: Sunday, May 25, 2025 Vodice - Krka National Park - Vodice This morning, venture to the breathtaking Krka National Park, where waterfalls tumble through dramatic gorges. Meander along the trails that surround the falls before embarking on a boat ride that takes you along the river to Skradin.* Enjoy your free time in Skradin before returning to Vodice. (B)

Day 11: Monday, May 26, 2025 Vodice - Zagreb This morning, travel to Zagreb, the capital of Croatia! Step right into the history and culture of everyday life as you tour the city with a local guide. Become acquainted with the city as you see the main sights of the capital, the Croatian Parliament building, the illustrious Zagreb Cathedral, and the legendary Stone Gate. Tonight, raise a glass and say *živjeli* (to life) as you toast your Croatian journey over Continental and Istrian cuisine. (B, D)

Day 12: Tuesday, May 27, 2025 Zagreb - Tour Ends Say goodbye to Croatia as your tour of the Adriatic Coast comes to a close today. (B)

Experience It! Krka National Park

Krka National Park is located in the Dalmatian region of Croatia and contains a section of the Krka River. Known for its cascading waterfalls and dramatic gorges, the park covers an area of over 50 square miles. Over the course of its seven waterfalls, the Krka River changes an altitude of almost 800 feet. The pristine pools at the base of the falls take on a blue-green hue as they glisten vibrantly in the sunlight. You can admire the falls from the footpaths spreading throughout the park. Then, for a more intimate look at the Krka River, discover the area by boat. Additionally, Krka National Park is home to over 1000 different species of plants. Make sure to keep an eye out for birds fluttering overhead, because 225 species call this park home.

IDENTIFICATION

Passports are required for this tour at your expense. Certain countries require a minimum of 6 months passport validity from date of return home. You are strongly urged to contact the appropriate consulate for details. Visit www.travel.state.gov for the U.S. State Department for the latest details about passports and visa requirements.

IMPORTANT: We recommend that our clients traveling abroad take a photocopy of their passport and applicable visas. It should be packed separately from your actual passport and visa. We also recommend leaving a copy at home with your emergency contact.

Effective for travel in 2024, all visitors who do not need a visa to enter Europe will be expected to apply for an ETIAS visa waiver, for a fee, when visiting a Schengen Area Country. To complete your tour, we include roundtrip airport-to-hotel transfers when purchasing our airfare with your tour. If you have arranged for your own air, we are pleased to provide you the option of *purchasing* these transfers. Please note that all transfers will leave at pre-scheduled times.

The days and order of sightseeing may change to best utilize your time on tour. Order of sightseeing on board the ship may vary based on departure and weather conditions and is at the sole discretion of the cruise line.

*Both the boat ride to Skradin and the Blue Cave operate on a weather-permitting basis and depending on water conditions.

Single accommodations are limited and are available on a first come, first served basis. Triple rooms are not available.

The overall activity level of this tour is a level 3. You're an on-the-go traveler. You don't want to miss a thing, so walking and standing for longer periods of time (2-3 hours) isn't a big deal. A moderately paced two-and-a-half-hour walking tour, covering several miles, hills, and uneven surfaces, is no problem for you. Walking four miles over the course of a day is very doable, as is climbing into and out of various modes of transportation (tuk-tuk, cable car, zodiac, etc.). You can climb three flights of stairs easily and handle altitudes between 6,000 and 9,000 feet. Expect some longer days with early mornings or late nights balanced with free time to recharge or set out on your own adventure. This level is not a fit for travelers who require mobility assistance devices.

Please be advised many airlines do not provide advance seat assignments until check-in at the airport. Advance seating will be subject to the airline's terms and conditions.

Air passengers will arrive into Dubrovnik airport and depart from Zagreb airport.

Embarkation on day 2 is upon arrival; however, cabins will not be ready for check in until after 1:00 p.m. Luggage can be left on board. Disembarkation on day 9 is at 9:00 a.m.

Cabins are available on the Standard Deck. Upgrades may be available to Main Deck. Cruise ships have a limited quantity of cabins available in each category. We will make every effort to accommodate your cabin category preference at time of



booking. If the cabin category preferred is not available, the next closest category available will be offered and a surcharge may apply. Stateroom numbers will be supplied upon arrival at the ship.

Onboard gratuities are not included in the price of your tour. Suggested tipping on board cruise: 13.50 US dollars (10-12 euros) per person for each day for the cruise staff. This can be made in a single payment in euros or US dollars at the front desk at the end of your voyage or by the envelopes provided in your cabin.

Economy air rate and schedule are applicable for groups of 10 or more traveling on the same flights and dates.

A deposit of \$898 per person is due upon reservation. Reservations are made on a first come, first served basis. Reservations made after the deposit due date of April 10, 2024 are based upon availability. Final payment due by January 16, 2025. Deposits are refundable up until April 17, 2024.
